Fifth Street Industrial Redevelopment Project Former Stamping Facility Toronto, Ohio

Partners has been hired by the City of Toronto, Ohio to assist them with the Fifth Street Industrial Redevelopment Project. This project involves environmental remediation of a former stamping facility that has trichloroethylene (TCE) soil and groundwater contamination from previous industrial activities. Partners prepared a Clean Ohio Assistance Fund (COAF) grant application on behalf of the City in February 2007. The Ohio Department of Development awarded a COAF grant for \$700,000 to the City to design and implement Soil Vapor Extraction systems and other remedies to remediate the TCE soil and groundwater contamination at the site.

Partners designed the SVE system and prepared the contract documents for public bid. Partners evaluated the bids and recommended a contractor for the City of Toronto to perform the SVE installation and other soil excavations. Representing the City of Toronto, Partners will be on-site to monitor the SVE system installations and excavation activities, and will also maintain and operate the SVE system and previously installed groundwater treatment pumping well. In addition to these tasks, Partners will also perform soil, air and groundwater sampling to monitor the SVE system's performance.

As these remedial activities are taking place, a new industrial tenant is moving their operations into the previously abandoned facility.
