



Partners Environmental, in conjunction with the Environmental, Health & Safety Technology (EHST) program at Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C), hosted Certified Professional (CP) Training for the purpose of obtaining Professional Development Hour Units (PDHUs) necessary to maintain certification under the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Voluntary Action Program (VAP).
